

Sydney Gardens - OO

Information for Exhibition Managers – 2015/16

Sydney Gardens is a 4mm scale, OO layout depicting the double-track Great Western main line through the famous Sydney Gardens in the City of Bath. It has been built by a consortium of experienced modellers associated with Gas Cupboard Models who collectively call themselves The Park Keepers. They have modelled the prototype scene as accurately as possible using traditional and modern scenic techniques, including custom-made papers, laser-cut bridge parts and 3D printing. A large fiddle yard enables a constant stream of trains passing through in both directions.



Sydney Gardens made its major debut at Chippenham in September 2014 followed by Calne in January 2015. And it has taken several further bookings for this year, including The Great Electric Train Show in October. It has also been photographed by Chris Nevard for a forthcoming feature in Model Rail magazine.
